<u>Committees</u> – In addition to a lead role, each individual will be assigned to a committee that will meet regularly with Liz & Andrew to discuss goal setting, progress towards goals, and logistics. You will be asked to select your preference for one of these committees and why you feel you are best suited for this selection. You will also have to list an alternate committee, as we are not going to be able to accommodate everyone's first request.

1. **Project Managers** – 8 per class

Meet with Liz & Andrew briefly on Mondays, Wed & Fridays – check in on teams progress etc. Set goals for group and report back on progress. Project managers help group organize, build morale, and guide team to successful project completion. Project managers are leaders and will be expected to demonstrate leadership behavior. A leader does not dictate or demand, rather helps the team to work together to meet a common goal.

- 2. **Exhibition Organizers** 8 per class (each class organizes a different exhibition) Meet with Liz & Andrew briefly on Tuesdays & Thursdays develop clear plan for both exhibitions. Organize all materials and logistics. "Tunes" ideas with the assistance of other exhibition team.
- 3. Publicity & Products Managers 8 per class

Meet with Liz & Andrew briefly on Tuesdays & Thursdays. Produce flyers & promotional materials for our project. Ensure that Andrew & Liz are apprised of any materials groups need. Acquire these materials for your teams. Organize for final display in the school. Make flyer for display board & publicity via email and other electronic media. Write Unboxed article on project + newspaper article to publicize events and the accomplishments of our class. Tasks will be divided so that the two groups are not overlapping and duplicating work.
