

In the next few weeks, you will be completing a case study on a culture (Latin America) and its use of a particular plant for the enhancement of well-being. You will learn about this plant and its use within that particular culture, noting its one or many uses, where the plants if found, what it looks like, its means of administration/use, and its significance. You will also attempt to identify this plant’s “active ingredient” and identify its “modern” equivalent. Finally, you will need to create a visual for your plant in the style of our personal legend images.

Requirements:

Research culture and its use of plant – keep note of where you find this information. PLANT must be written down (no duplicates) on sign-up sheet. Take a minute to pick a plant / culture group that interests you.

- What are the plants uses?
- Where is the plant found?
- What does the plant look like?
- What are its means of administration / use?
- What is its significance within the cultural group?
- What is / might be its “active ingredient”?
- What is/are the “modern” equivalent(s)?

Create professional looking image using techniques used for personal legend.

Professionally present this information (see template). This template will be similar, but not exactly the same for our San Diego plant.
